### 2024 Elizabethan Award Recipient Mayor Herb Roach, City of O'Fallon, IL



HSHS St. Elizabeth's Foundation is honored to present Mayor Herb Roach, City of O'Fallon, Illinois, with the 2024 Elizabethan Award on Nov. 1, 2024. The award recognizes Mayor Roach for his commitment to St. Elizabeth's Hospital and the expansion of health care services in Southwestern Illinois.

Mayor Roach is a longtime advocate of St. Elizabeth's Hospital and has championed the expansion of our mission as a community member, business owner, alderman and mayor. His relationship

with St. Elizabeth's Hospital dates back to childhood. As he recalls, "Growing up, St. Elizabeth's was always our hospital. My mother, my sister and I were born there. We have had children, grandchildren and great grandchildren born and treated there. My grandparents and parents left from there to meet with the Lord. It's always been special to me and my family and to the region. So, when I had the opportunity to help grow and expand the mission of the Hospital Sisters, I was all in. There was no question of my support of the work of the staff of HSHS."

Since Herb Roach became mayor in 2017, his support of St. Elizabeth's Hospital related projects has led to significant growth in the availability of health care services in the metro east. The current state-of-the-art hospital opened in late 2017 and continues to see robust utilization by patients in the O'Fallon area and the surrounding region. In the following years, new care locations were opened, including the HSHS St. Elizabeth's Outpatient Therapy Clinic at the Metro Rec Plex in 2019 and the O'Fallon Cancer Care Center in 2020. Additional expansion and renovation projects occurred at the HSHS St. Elizabeth's O'Fallon Medical Building on North Green Mount Road, including the remodeling of areas of St. Elizabeth's Convenient Care and the expansion of diagnostic imaging services with the addition of a new open MRI.

Mayor Roach is a champion for accessible health care, a true community partner, and a friend of St. Elizabeth's Hospital. We are honored to present him with the 2024 Elizabethan Award.
