The nursing student scholarship provided by HSHS in Illinois offers funding for educational expenses up to a maximum of \$10,000 for a two-year pledge. The scholarship is awarded each semester to qualifying students attending St. John's College of Nursing.

The priority application review cycle is from March 1 – 31, 2025.

Applications are reviewed upon submission, and top candidates are chosen for interviews. Applicants should have an interest in working in an HSHS Illinois hospital as an RN upon graduation and passing boards.
